Venue

The EAC Annual Meeting will take place in the LVR-LandesMuseum Bonn, Colmantstr. 14-16, 53115 Bonn.

The LVR-LandesMuseum Bonn is one of the oldest historic museums in Germany. The museum's permanent collection displays 400.000 years of history – ranging from the skeleton of the eponymous Neanderthal man and the gravestone of Marcus Caelius, who died in the Varus defeat, to a collection of contemporary art. How to get to Bonn from the Cologne/Bonn airport

By bus: The bus line SB 60 (Airport bus) is a shuttle and runs frequently between the airport and Bonn city centre. Bonn train station ("Hauptbahnhof") is the end of the line.

By train/tram: There are several connections by train and tram and you can find the most suitable one [here](#).

By taxi: Of course you can also go by taxi, to Bonn city centre the travel time is about 15 min. and the price is approx. 40 EUR.

Sightseeing in Bonn

Besides the LVR-LandesMuseum Bonn there are many other locations worth a visit. Here are some suggestions:

[Beethoven-Haus Bonn](#), Bonngasse 22-24, 53111 Bonn: Beethoven's birthplace is today place of commemoration, museum and an institute for culture with various responsibilities.

Bonner Münster / Cathedral, Gerhard-von-Are-Str. 5, 53111 Bonn: The Bonner Münster, also called Münsterbasilica, is the catholic main church in Bonn and the town's landmark.

Altes Rathaus, Markt 2, 53111 Bonn: The old town hall at the market square was built in 1737/38 in the Rococo style by the elector's builder Michael Leveilly, but finalised only in 1780.

Castle Poppelsdorf / Botanical Gardens, Meckenheimer Allee 171/169, 53115 Bonn: A baroque palace near the botanical gardens of Bonn's university, which belong to the oldest documented botanical gardens, rich in tradition, in Germany.

Rheinaue, Ludwig-Erhard-Allee 20, 53175 Bonn: A 160 hectare local recreation area, designed as a park.

Zoological Research Museum Alexander Koenig, Adenauerallee 160, 53113 Bonn: Museum of natural sciences and part of the Leibniz institute for analysis of the changes in biodiversity.

Cherry-Blossoms, HeerstraÙe, 53111 Bonn: Depending on the weather conditions, we could be lucky to have the famous Cherry-Blossoms in Bonn at the time of the Symposium. Fingers crossed!

Bundeskunsthalle, Helmut-Kohl-Allee 4, 53113 Bonn: The Art and Exhibition Hall of the Federal Republic of Germany (in short: Bundeskunsthalle) is one of the museums with the most visitors per year in Germany and shows changing exhibitions with famous art treasures and cultural assets of worldwide origin.

Haus der Geschichte, Willy-Brandt-Allee 14, 53113 Bonn: The „House of History“ is a museum for German contemporary history since 1945.
